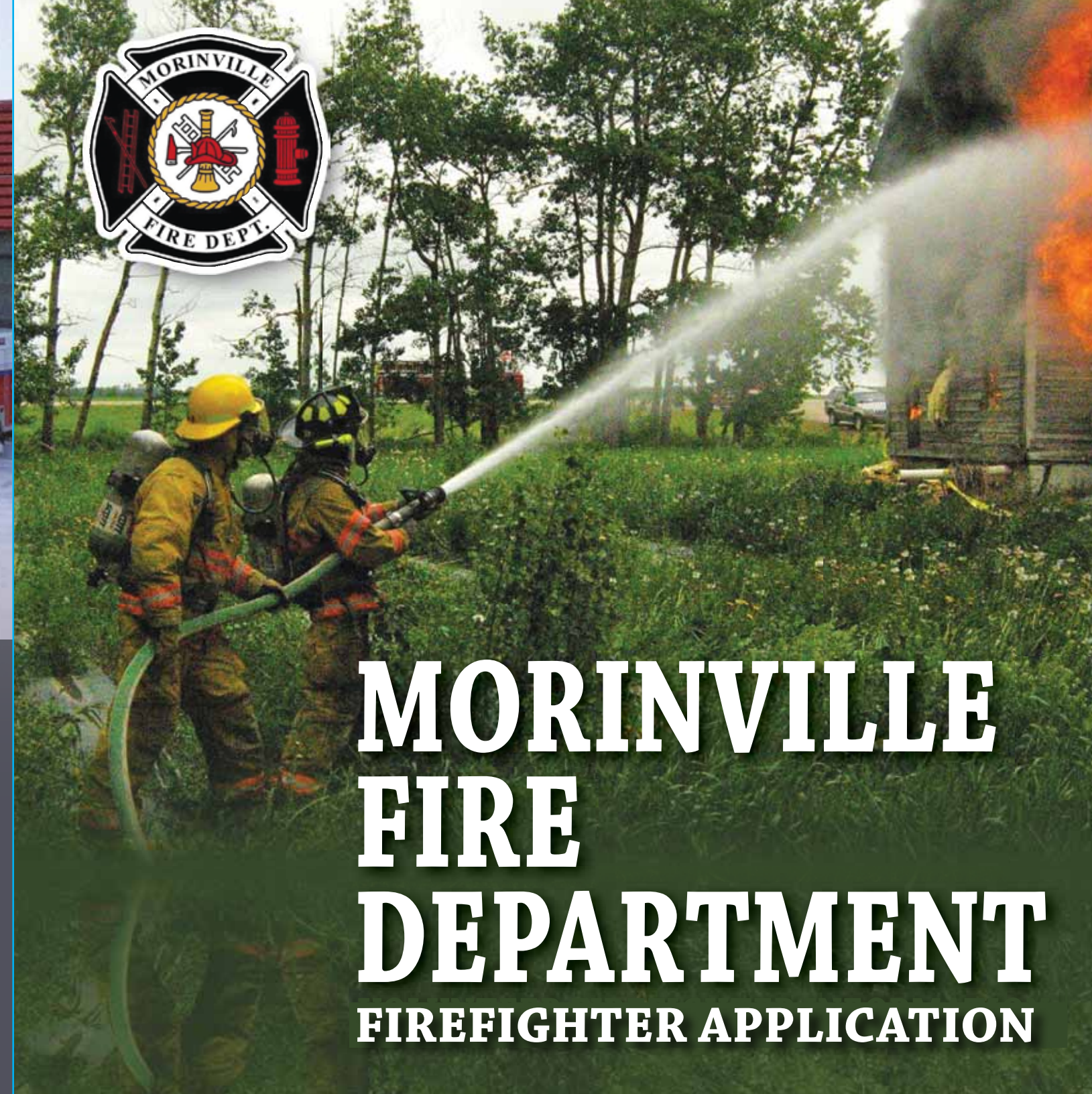

TRAINING

HONORARIUM

Morinville fire department is a paid on-call department. Members are paid an honorarium when called to respond to emergencies. Most stand-by, training and public relations time is volunteer and you can expect that you will contribute 200-300 hours a year.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

WHO ARE MORINVILLE FIREFIGHTERS?



Morinville Fire Department firefighters are your neighbors, your co-workers and your friends. They are men and women from all walks of life that live close to you and respond whenever paged to deal with the emergencies in our community. They are people who choose to give more than they take from their community.

APPLICANTS MUST HAVE:

COMMITMENT: Emergencies can happen 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Firefighters are expected to respond to emergency callouts whenever available. Members are also required to fulfill weekend call crew duties on a rotating basis.

TIME: Firefighters are required to attend three hour, weekly training sessions (Wednesday nights).

GOOD HEALTH: Firefighting is a strenuous job, both mentally and physically. Members are encouraged to maintain a healthy and active lifestyle.

CLEAN CRIMINAL RECORD: Applicants are required to provide an RCMP criminal record check with their application.

VALID ALBERTA DRIVER'S ABSTRACT: A class 3 license with an air brake endorsement is preferred and a driver's abstract is required.

RESIDENT OF MORINVILLE: Applicants must live within the Town of Morinville.
