

Blue Bag Recycling Upcoming Changes Effective January 1, 2019

The National Sword in China has imposed strict restrictions on scrap paper & plastic imports.

This has had a significant impact on North American access to recycling markets. Municipalities' markets and pricing for recyclable materials have also been impacted by new, and currently unattainable, quality standards.

As a result, the recycling program in Morinville will see changes **effective January 1, 2019**.

Items such as glass bottles and jars, single serve 'to-go' coffee cups, styrofoam, some plastics and clamshell containers will **no longer** be accepted nor collected in the Blue Bag Recycling stream. Those items will be required to be disposed of primarily in your waste cart or at a recycling facility.

ACCEPTABLE

- **Boxboard** (e.g. cereal & crackers)
- **Books** (with hard and soft covers removed)
- Bottle deposit containers (not including glass)
- **V** Flattened corrugated cardboard (max: 3 ft × 3 ft)
- **✓** Flattened milk jugs/containers
- Food tin/steel cans (must be rinsed)
- Hard plastic tubs, bottles lids & containers
 (Grade 1 & 2 plastic only | must be rinsed)
- ✓ Magazines & phone books
- ✓ Newspapers & flyers
- Office paper, envelopes & craft paper
- ✓ Paper egg cartons
- Paper greeting cards, gift wrap and tissue paper (no foil, glitter or decorations)

UNACCEPTABLE

- Chip cans & spiral wound containers
- Coffee pods & drink pouches
- Electronics and hazardous waste
- Glass bottles, jars, and containers (accepted at the *Mike Mitchell Recycling Depot)
- Non-deposit tetra pak containers
- Non-packaging plastics (e.g. lawn chairs, toys)
- Plastic bags, wrappers & wrap (recycling drop off at St. Albert Walmart)
- Plastic clamshell packaging
- Plastic dishware, ceramics & glassware
- Scrap metal and construction/demolition materials
- Shredded paper, napkins, tissues, paper towels & tissue paper (accepted in organics)
- Single-use cups (e.g. yogurt, pudding) and to-go cups (e.g. coffee, fountain drinks)
- Single use plastic straws & utensils
- Styrofoam products
